**Preschool: August 25, 2026-May 20, 2027**

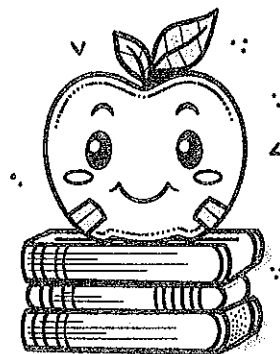
### **Pre-3 (3-year-old):**

Must be age 3 by August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2026.

### **Pre-K (4-,5-year-old):**

Must be age 4 by August 30<sup>th</sup>, 2026.

Preschool age children must be potty trained by Aug 15<sup>th</sup>.
